They seduce and release demonic forces and activity into your life.

God is the Same

Three wills are involved when making decisions. God’s “*perfect will*”, which establishes His plan and then there is His “*permissive will*”, tied to lessons to learn. Lastly, there is “*your will*”. You’ve already done all you know and can, and nothing has changed. Regardless of how much we think we want or need a particular man, you have to come into the realization that *failure preserves destiny’s plan*. Page 28
